National salvation government now!

The European summit went very badly for Greece. Many, even those considered friends of Greece, openly discussed the possibility of Grexit, and Greece came close to the national disaster of the new drachma. The Europeans, after a fruitless multi-month negotiation and the disastrous referendum, do not trust Mr. Tsipras. They demand that the Greek parliament pass immediately the relevant laws of the agreement framework, and the actual acceptance of the new agreement by a large part of the Greek political system.

The terms of the agreement framework are tough for Greece. Many issues, such as the issue of the immediate bridge loan, are still open. However, the support of 251 MPs to the negotiation proposals of Tsipras shows that the Greek MPs correctly express the strong support for the Euro that prevails in the Greek society! The highest expression of this strong support will be the creation of a national unity/salvation government that would vote for the agreement as well as its implementation. Additionally, because of stronger power, such a government will be able to negotiate better terms in the large number of remaining issues. Such a government should be a government of politicians who will shoulder the political responsibility of the tough measures. Technocrats cannot shoulder the political responsibility of the agreement. New Democracy, Potami, Pasok and Syriza should agree to form such a government immediately. As we can see from all parts of the globe (Europe, USA, Russia, China) only in this way we will survive in the Euro! Now is the time to be brave!
